

Viewing Cost History for a Non-Capitalized Asset

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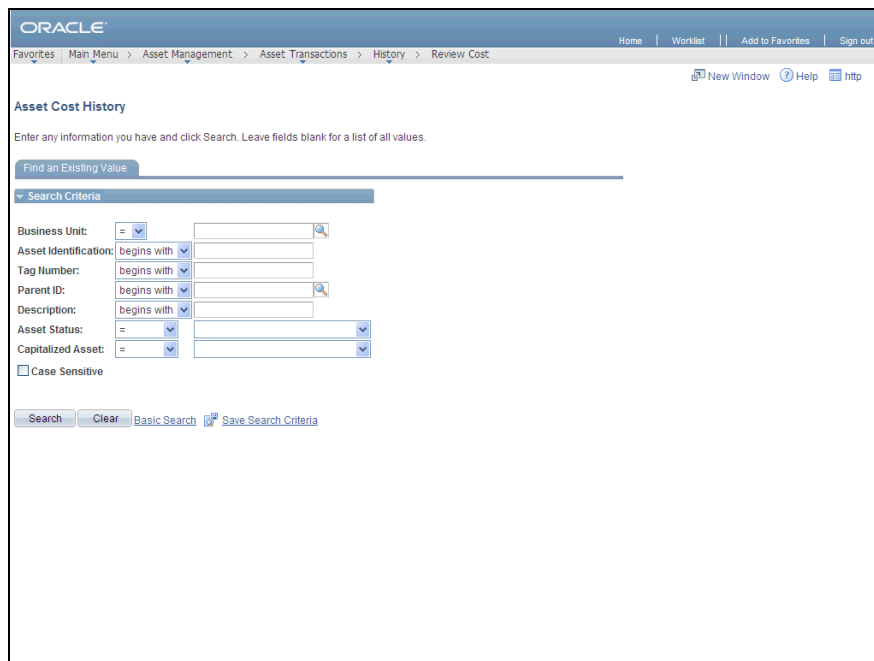



Users can review transactions that have been performed against an asset by using the **Review Cost** component. The **Cost History** and **Cost History Detail** tabs display information about transactions that affected the capitalized cost of an asset. The **Non Cap History List** and **Non Cap History Detail** tabs display summary and detail information about transactions that affected the non-capitalized costs associated with an asset.

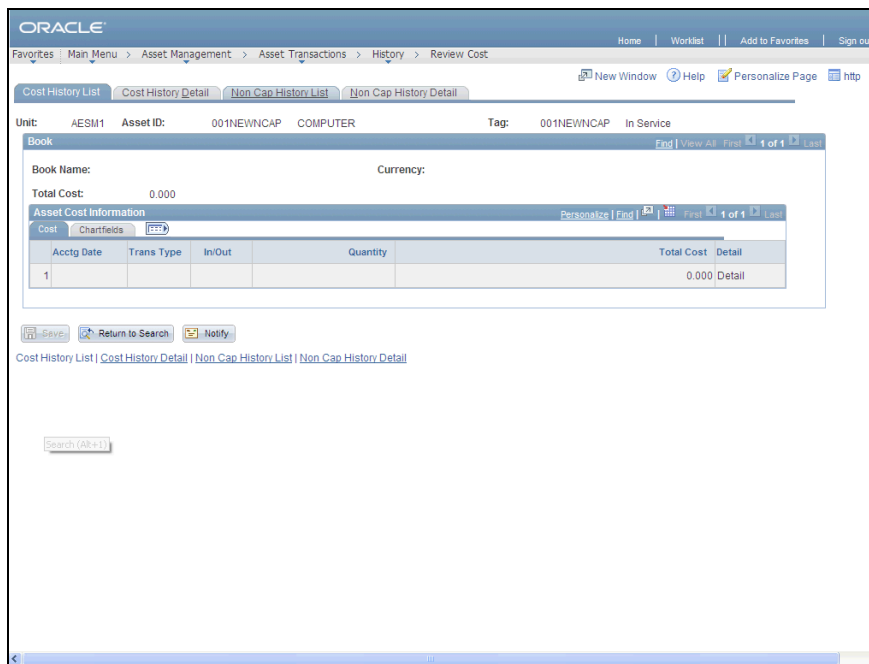
In this example a user reviews the cost history of the non-capitalized asset added in the previous topic, *Adding a Non-Capitalized Asset Using Basic Add*. This asset has no capitalized costs.


Procedure

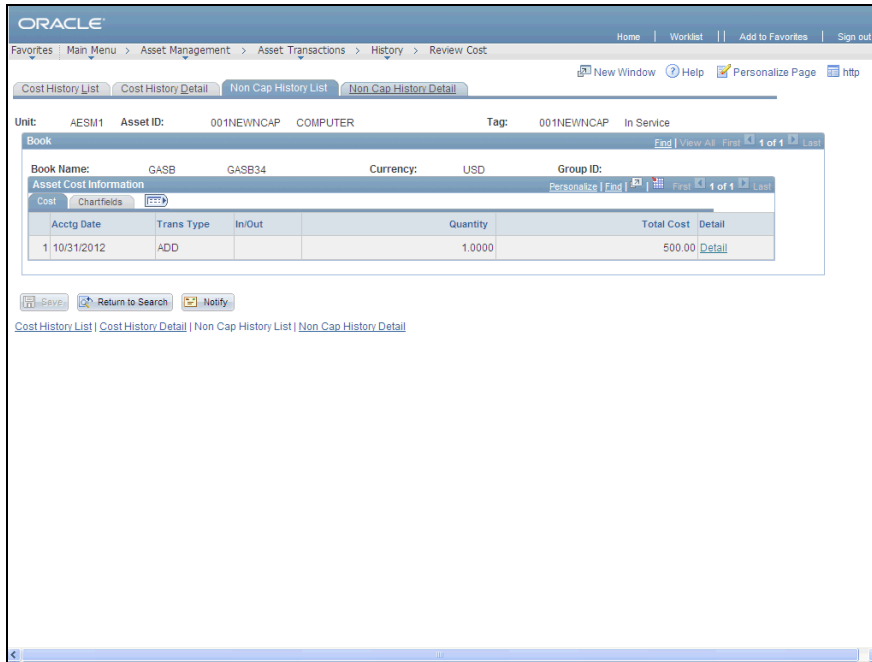
Navigation: Asset Management > Asset Transactions > History > Review Cost




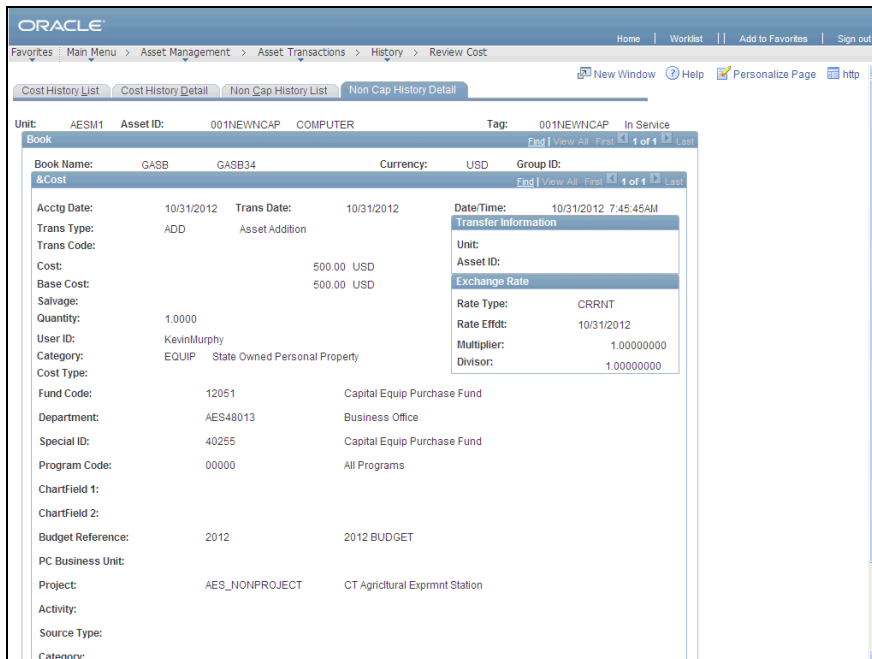
Step	Action
1.	Use the Asset Cost History Find an Existing Value page to locate the asset to review. Enter AESM1 into the Business Unit field.
2.	Enter 001NEWNCAP into the Asset Identification field.
3.	Click the Search button. 



Step	Action
4.	The Cost History List and Cost History Detail tabs display information about any non-capitalized costs associated with the asset. In this example there are no capitalized costs associated with the asset.
5.	Click the Non Cap History List tab. 



Step	Action
6.	The Asset Cost Information grid on the Non Cap History List tab displays information about the non-capitalized cost of the asset. Each row on the grid represents a different transaction.
7.	Click the Non Cap History Detail tab. 



Step	Action
8.	The Non Cap History Detail tab displays details for a row on the Asset Cost Information grid including ChartField information.
9.	End of Procedure.
